How to Create a Strong Password



Number 1



Don't Reuse Passwords

Reusing passwords is risky, if one site you use is breached that password could leak and if it's the same as your banking or email password then those are effectively compromised as well.



Number 2



Use a Password Manager

It's easier to create complex hard to guess passwords when you don't have to remember all of them yourself. We use LastPass but there many password manager options out there now.



Number 3



Create a Random Password

The best kind of password is random, especially a random phrase. MyHotDogIsBlue78. is better than Hotdog78. Bonus: sentence passwords are also easier to type.

Don't Use Personal Information

Avoid using any personal information that would be easy to guess, like your birthday, phone number or street address. The best passwords are as we said above, random.
